## **CONDITION OF CARGO**

- Cargo must be safe to move at either 36 Fahrenheit (chilled) or 0 Fahrenheit (frozen)
- Temperature of cargo must be within the listed guidelines below: If cargo is outside these limits, the Consignee will be called for faxed written instructions prior to acceptance

Ice Cream – within 5 degrees of booking temperature or documented temperature at time of delivery

Frozen Cargo – must be below 30 degrees at time of delivery

Chilled Cargo – must be within 10 degrees of documented temperature at time of delivery

- Bonded cargo will not be accepted with any discrepancy in piece count
- Cargo must be in acceptable condition on pallets (pallet provided)
- Cargo must have marks showing consignee name and cargo destination
- Truckers must present an inland waybill with documented temperature and booking number clearly noted
- Cargo presented "shrink wrapped" is accepted as one unit and remains intact throughout the shipment. Tropical will not be responsible for piece count of shrink-wrapped pallets
- Documents, including invoices, must be delivered with cargo OR sent to <u>invoices@tropical.com</u>. Cargo without invoices will not be accepted until documents are received
